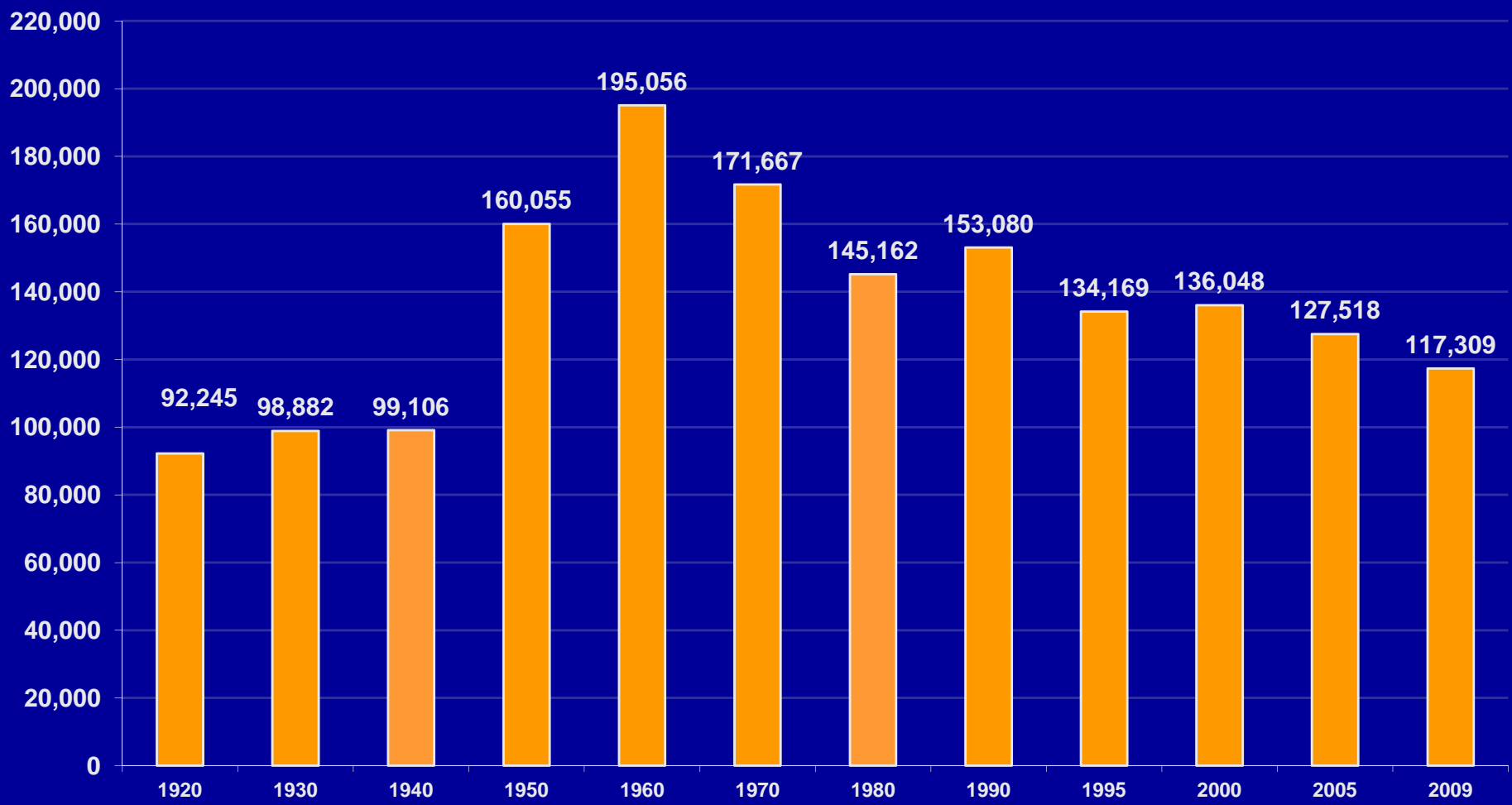

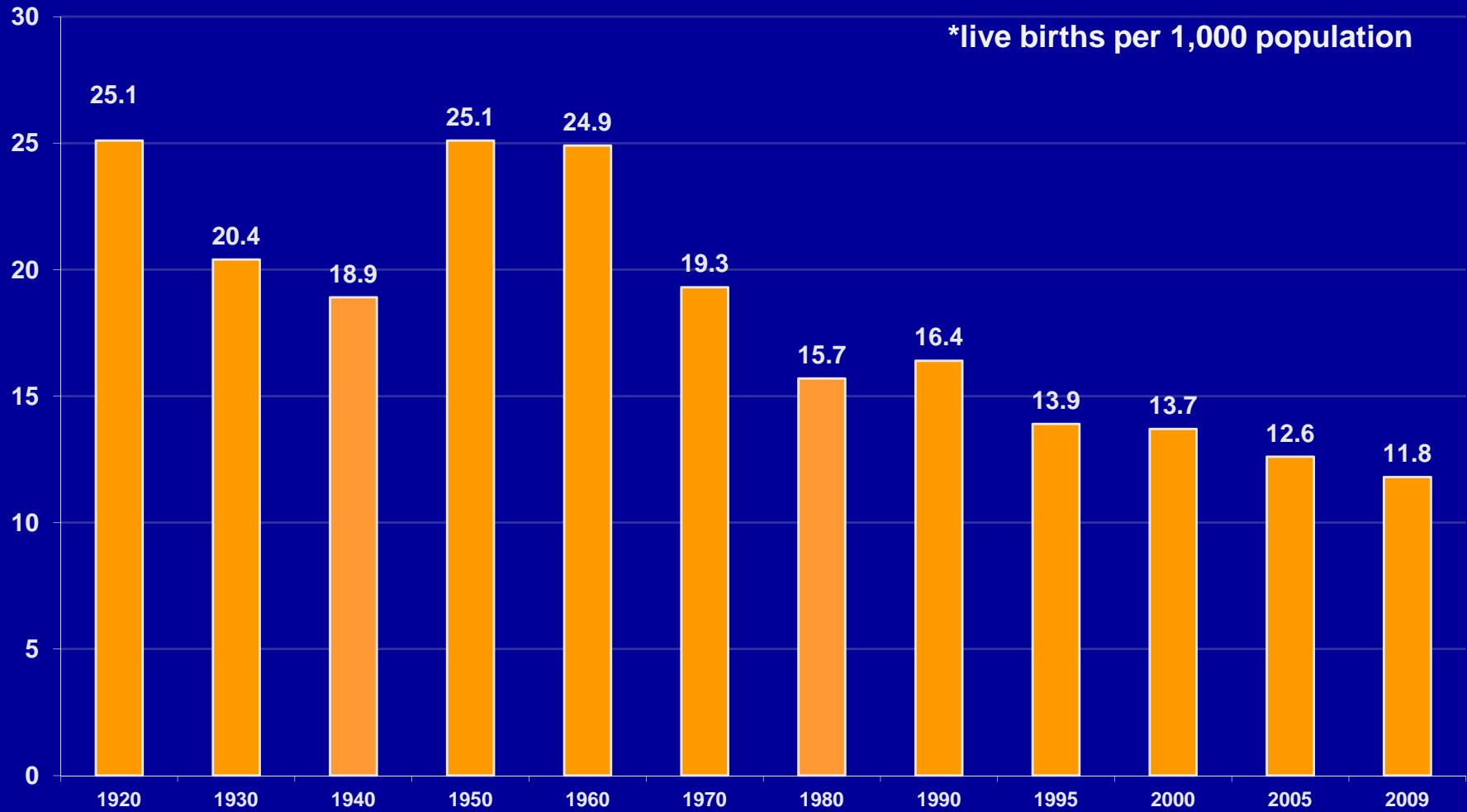

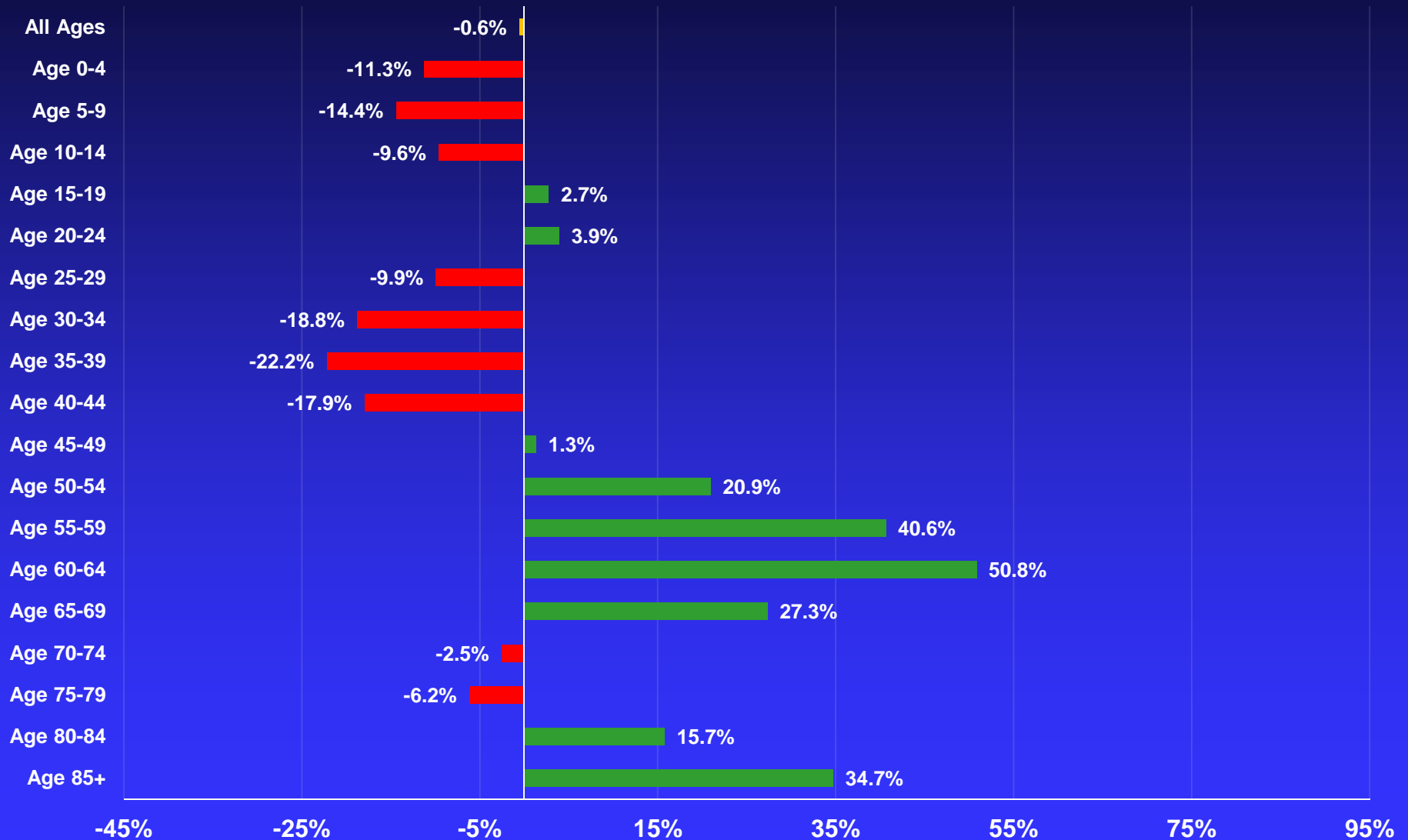
Michigan's Birth Rate* Clearly Shows the Post War Jump, Followed by a Relatively Steady Decrease



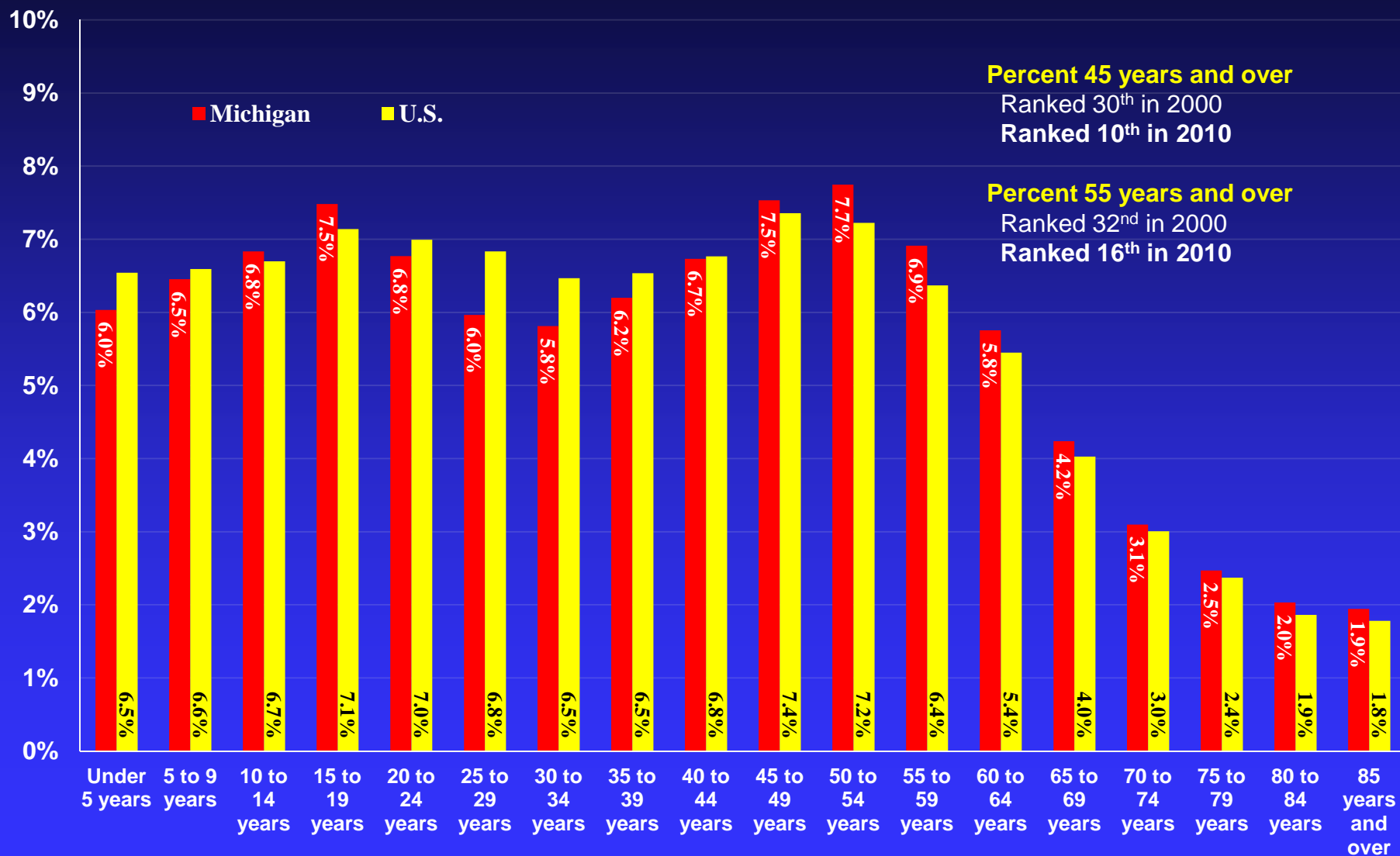

Michigan Trends Higher Than the Nation in its Share of Population in All Cohorts from 45 Years of Age On



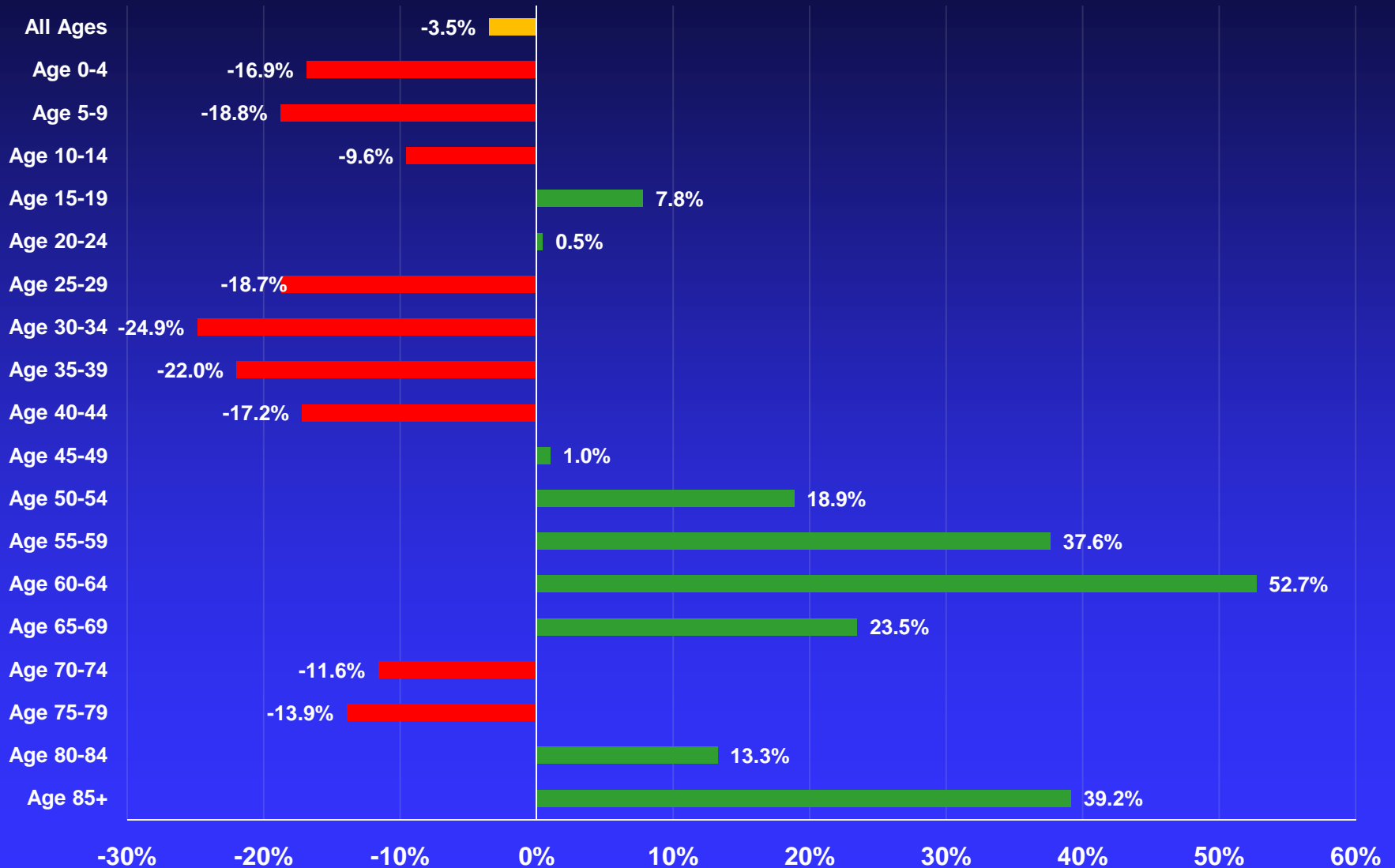
The Percent of Michigan Residents Who Are Native Decreases with Age

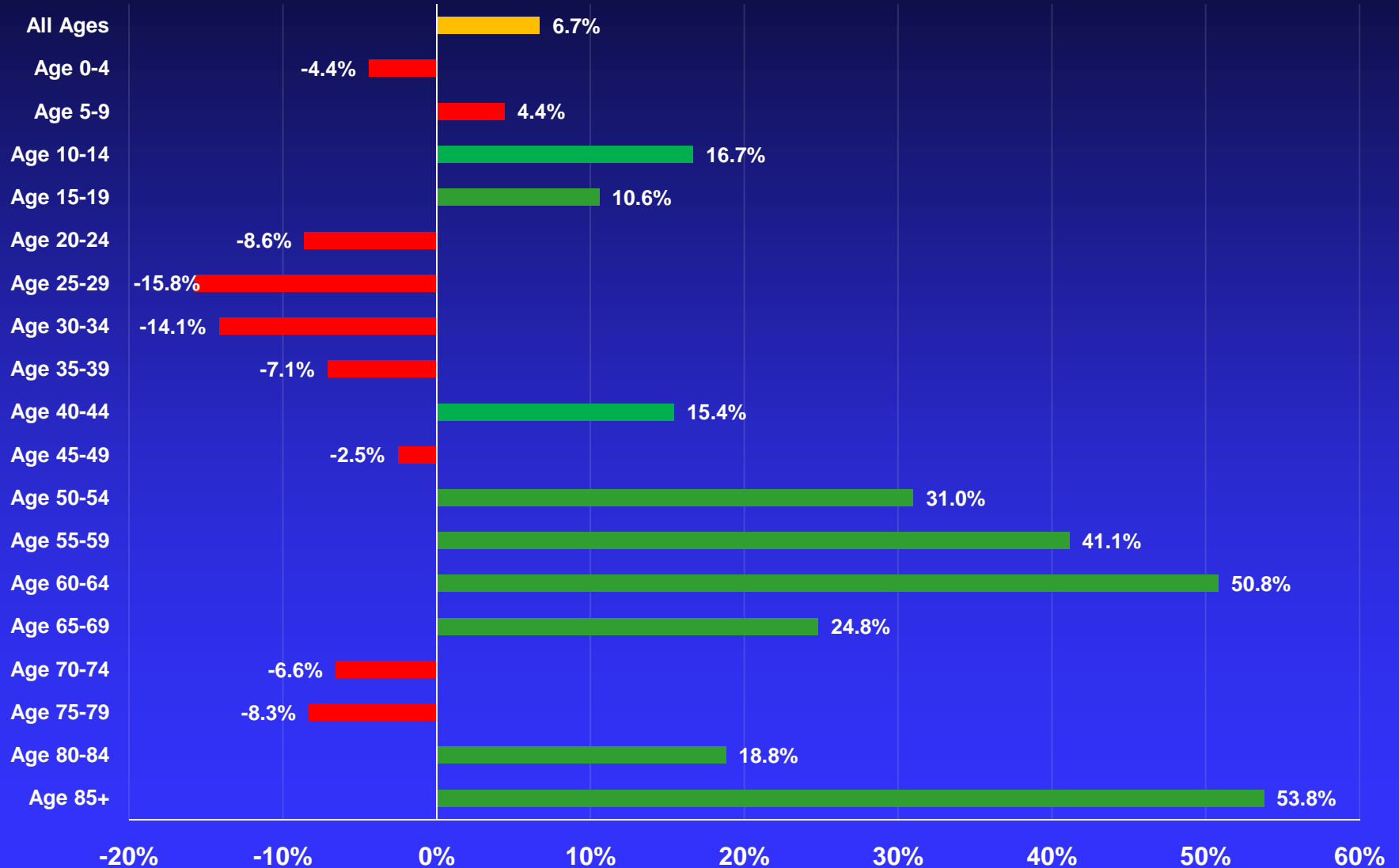
2000 – 2010 Population Change by Age Group

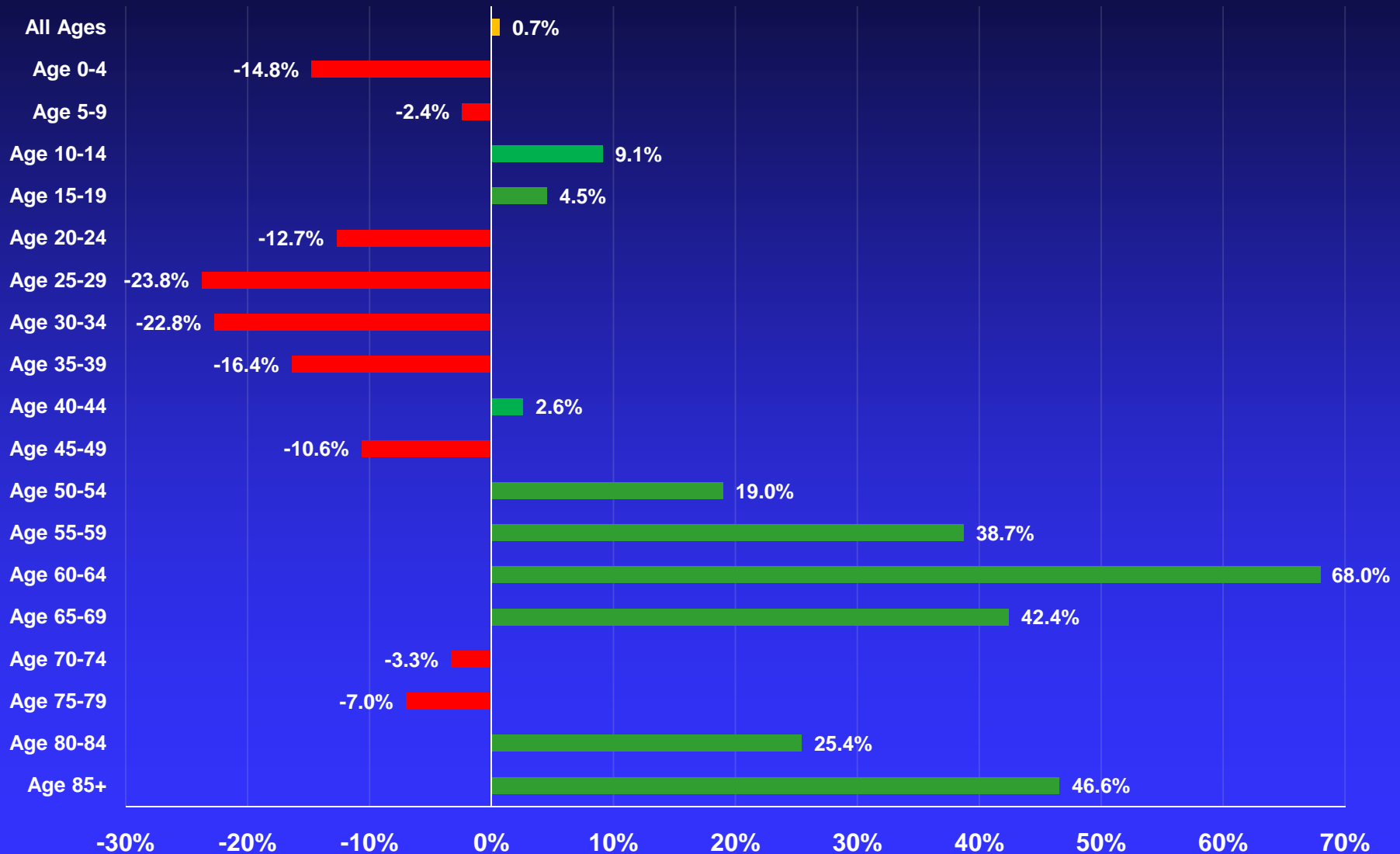
2000 – 2010 Population Change by Age Group

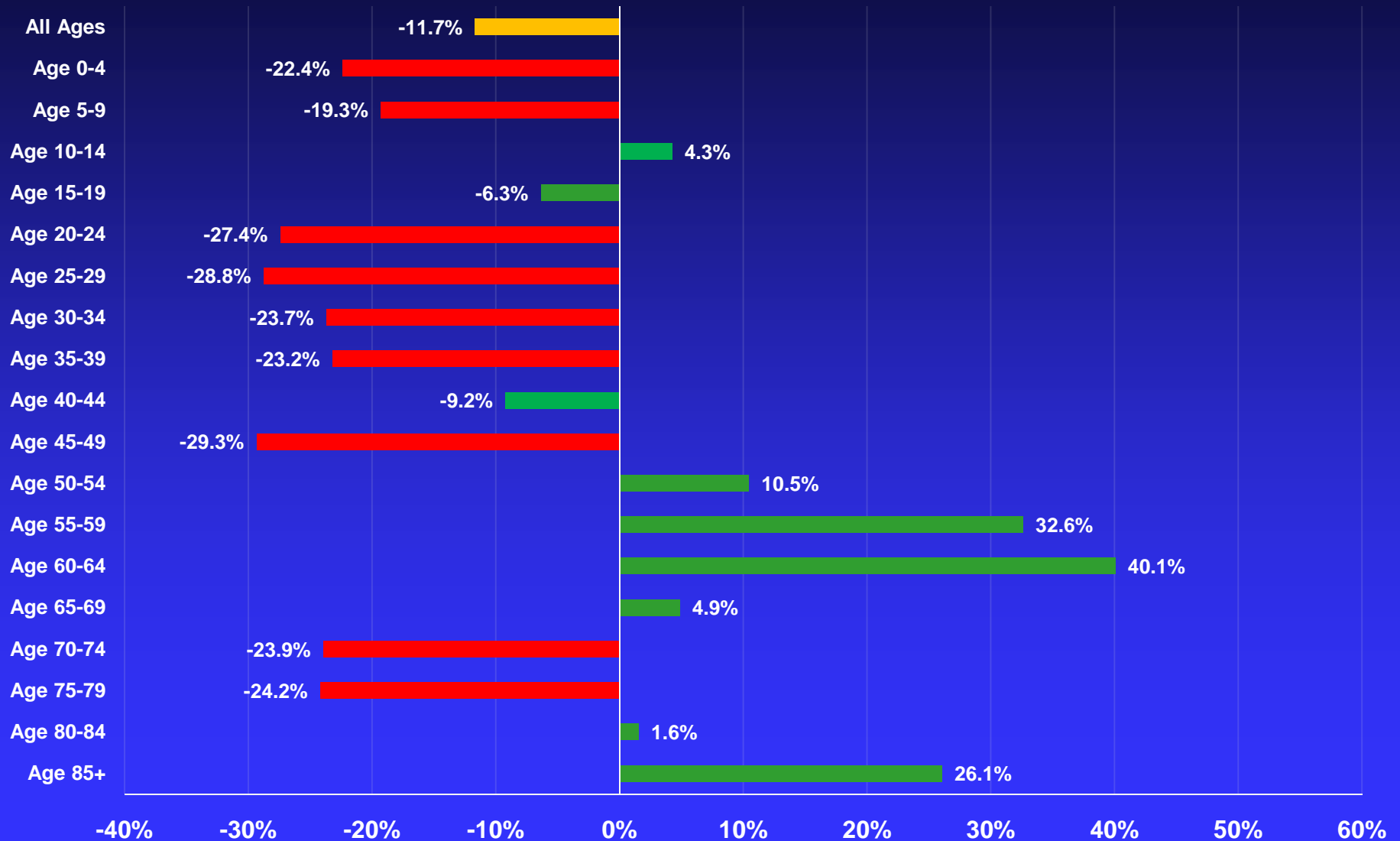
2000 – 2010 Population Change by Age Group

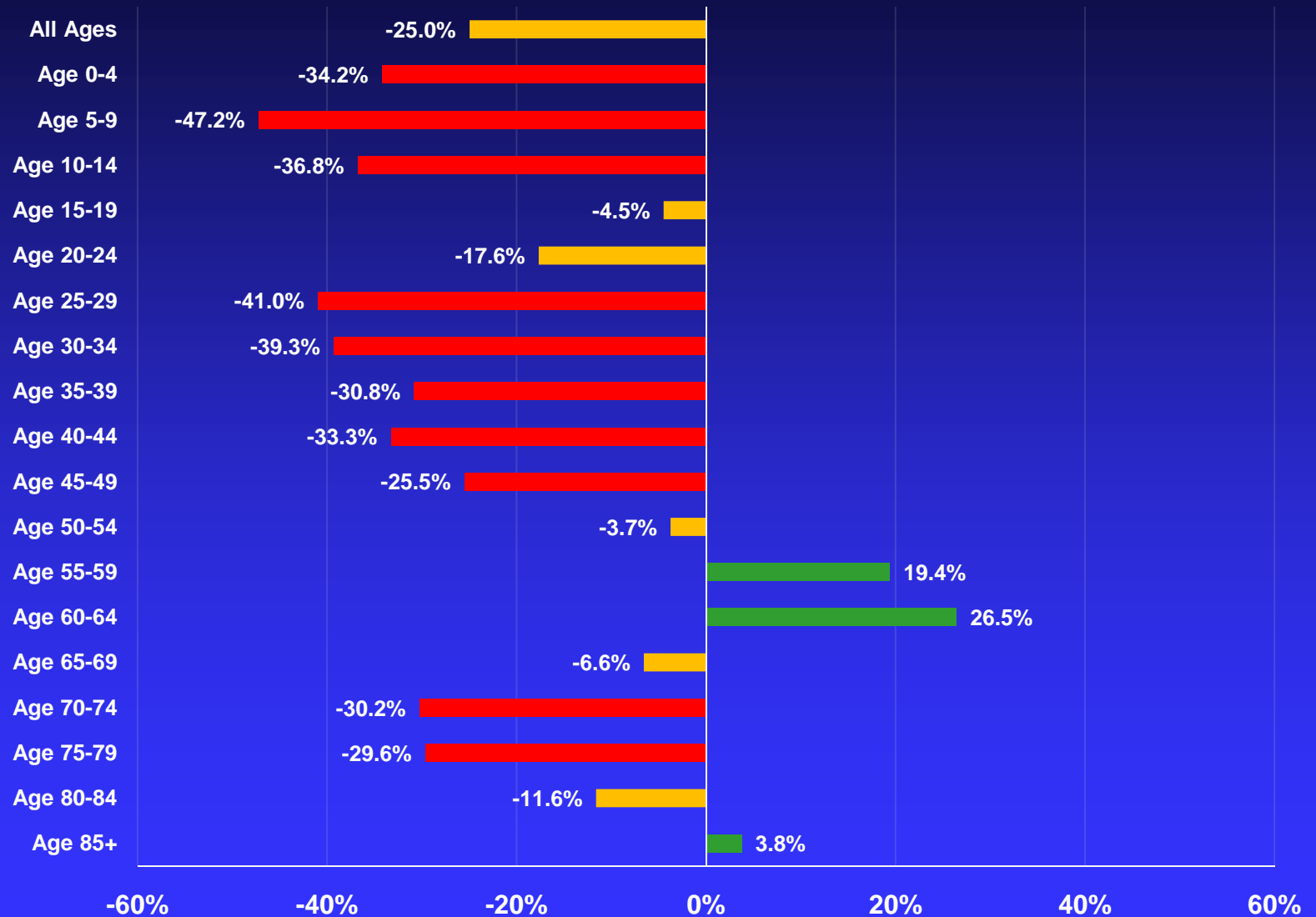
2000 – 2010 Population Change by Age Group

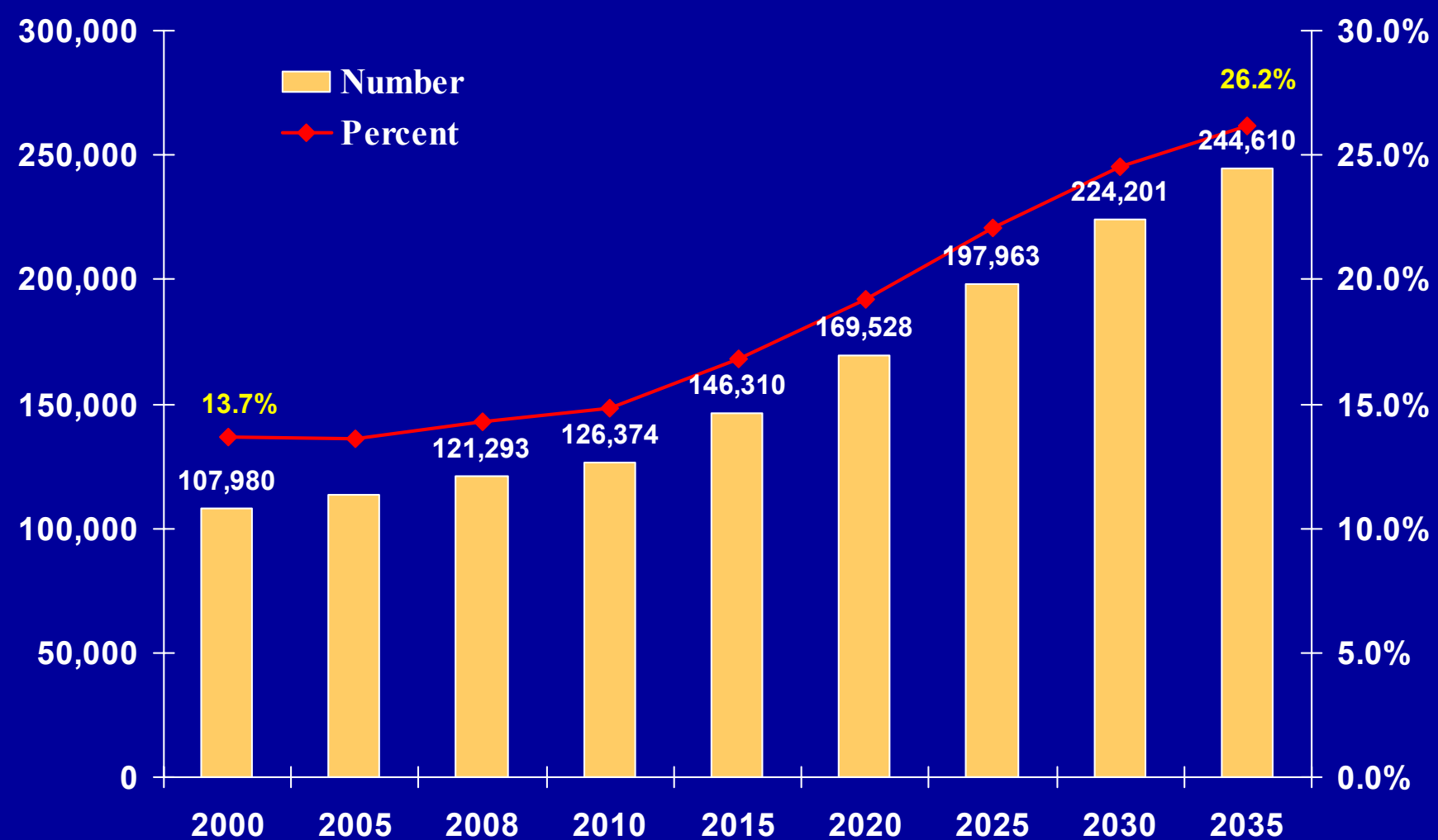


2000 – 2010 Population Change by Age Group

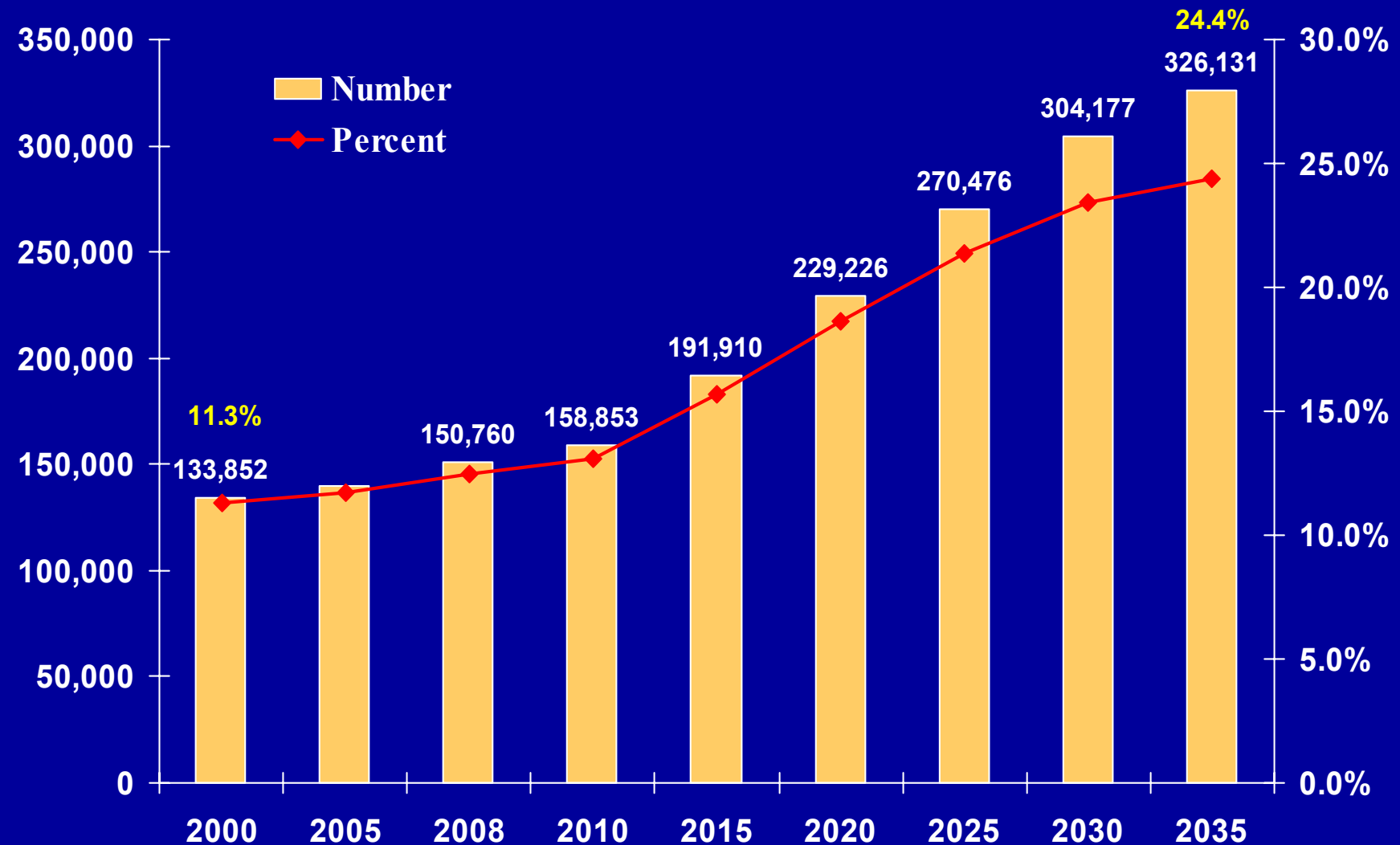


Macomb County Will Lead the Region in Growth and Share of Population for Seniors



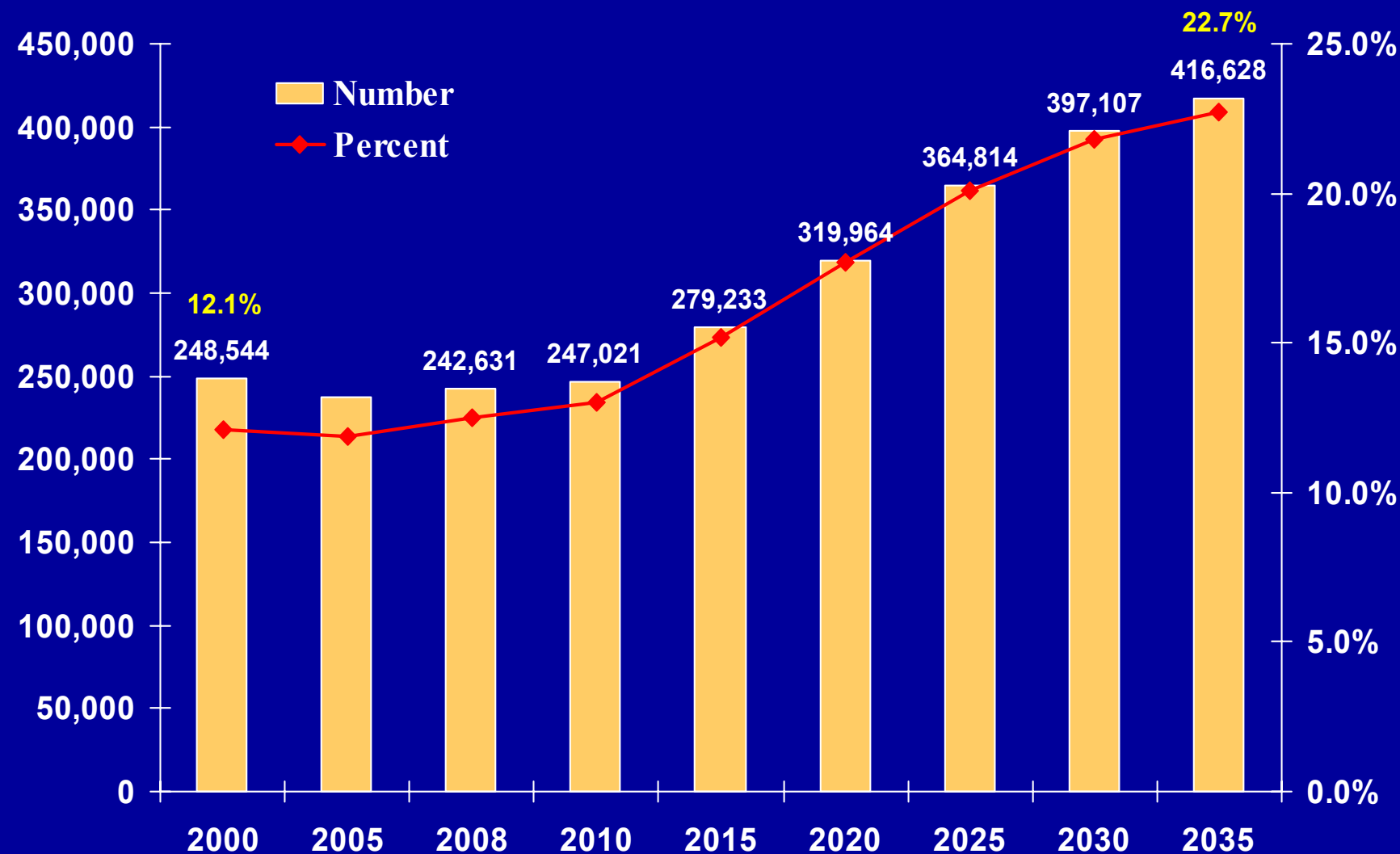

Oakland County Will Experience a Doubling of the Senior Population Over Next 20 Years



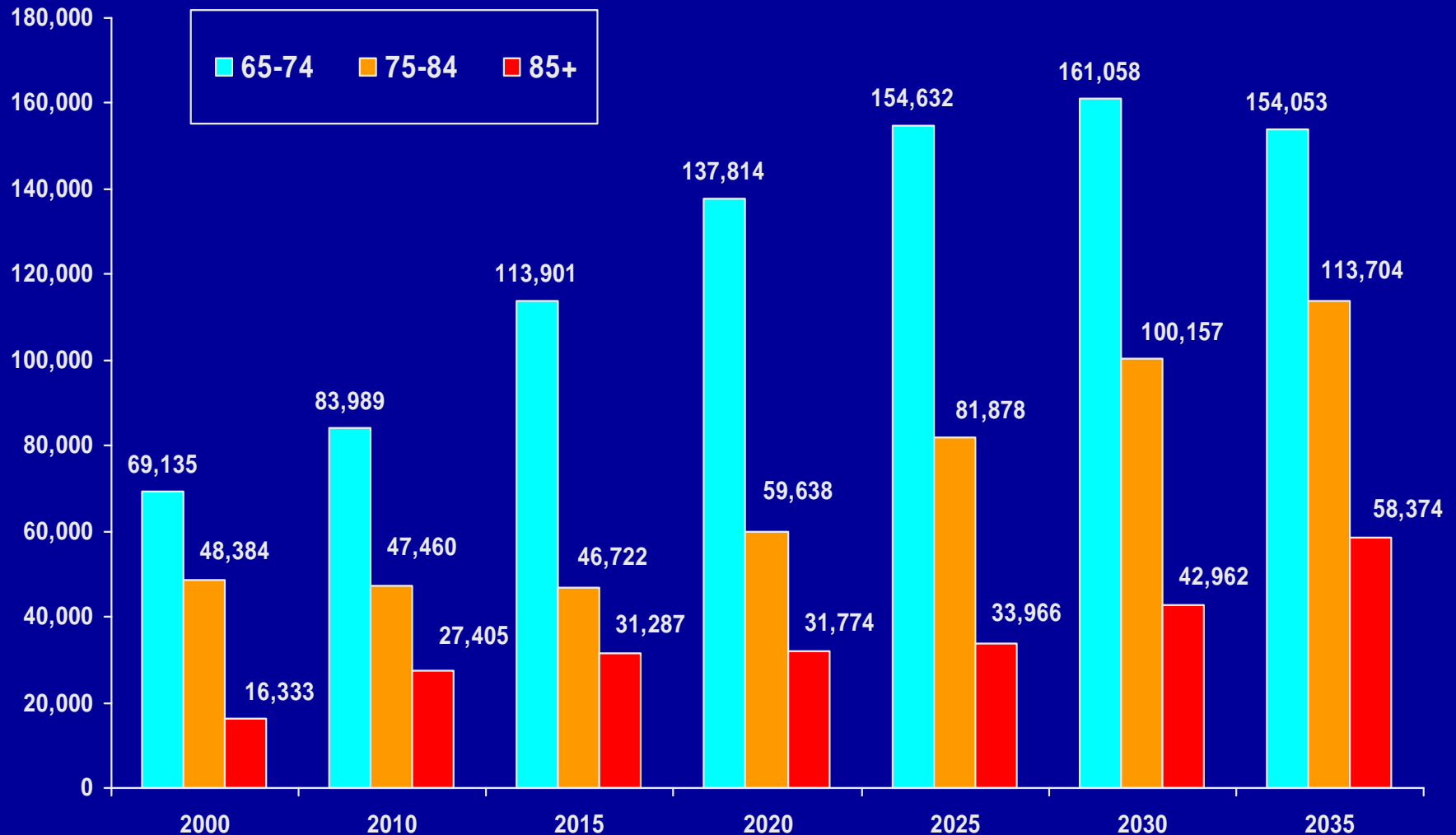

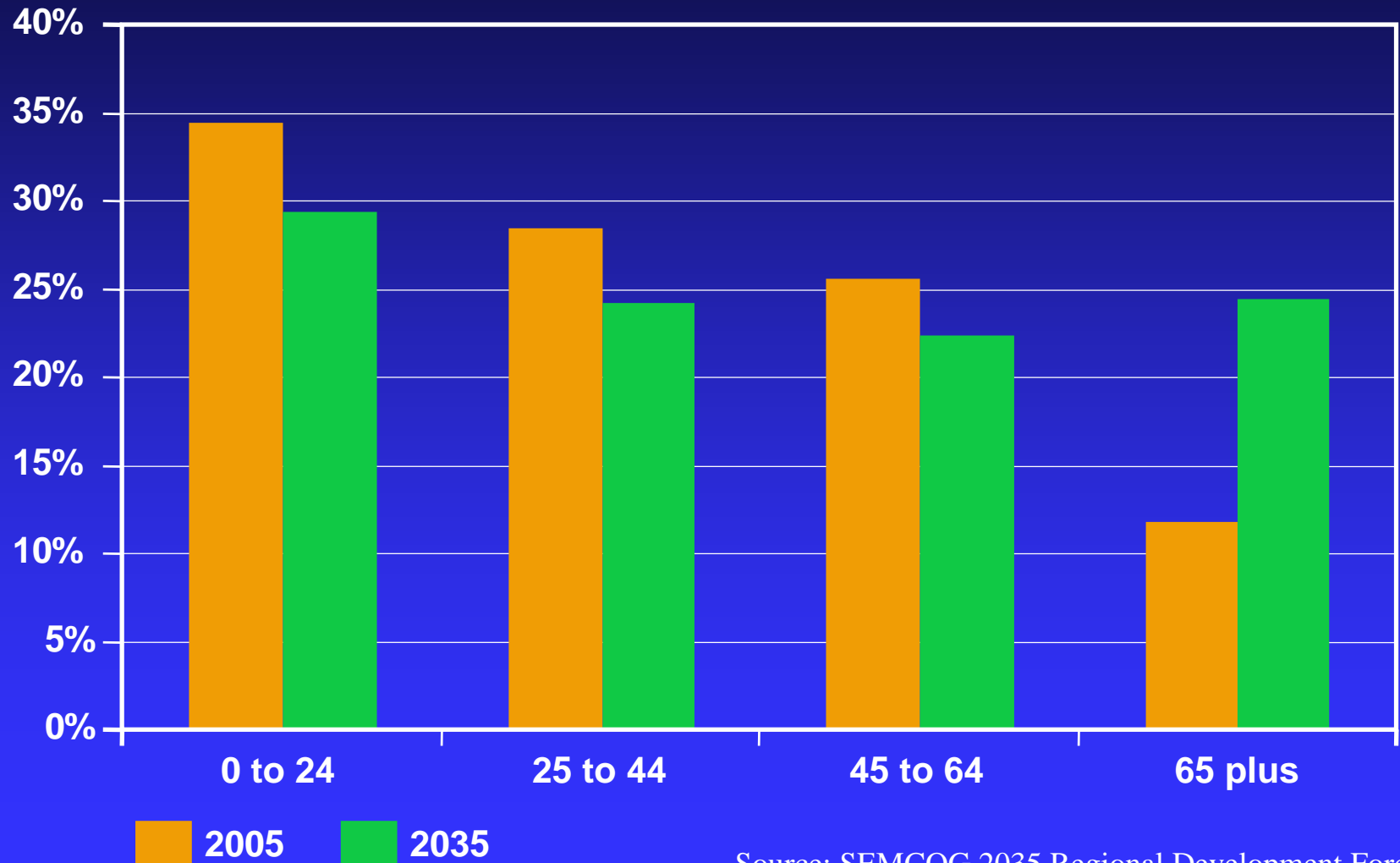
Senior Population Growth Will Accelerate in the “Older” Segments Beginning in 2021

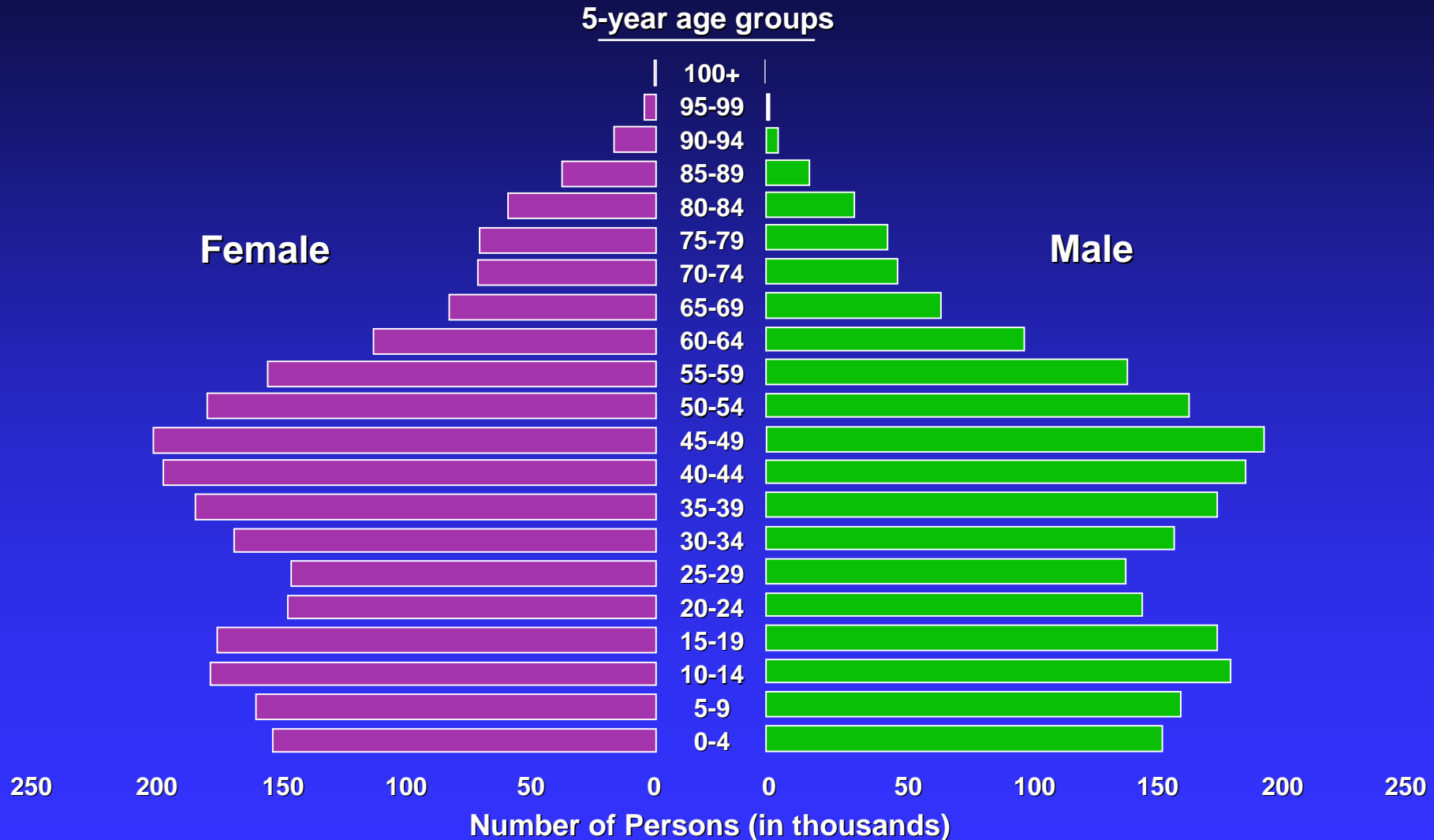
Southeast Michigan, 2005 and 2035

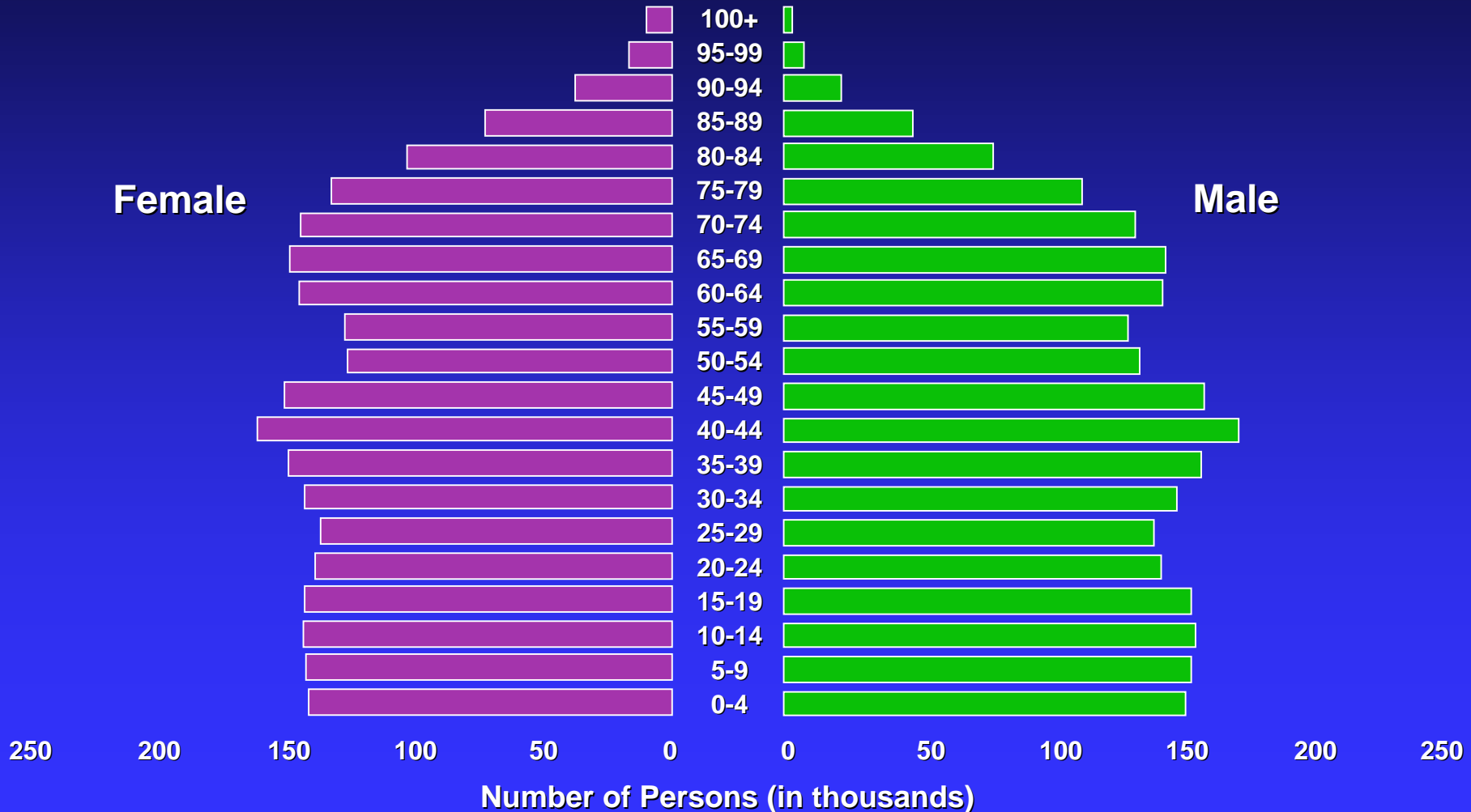

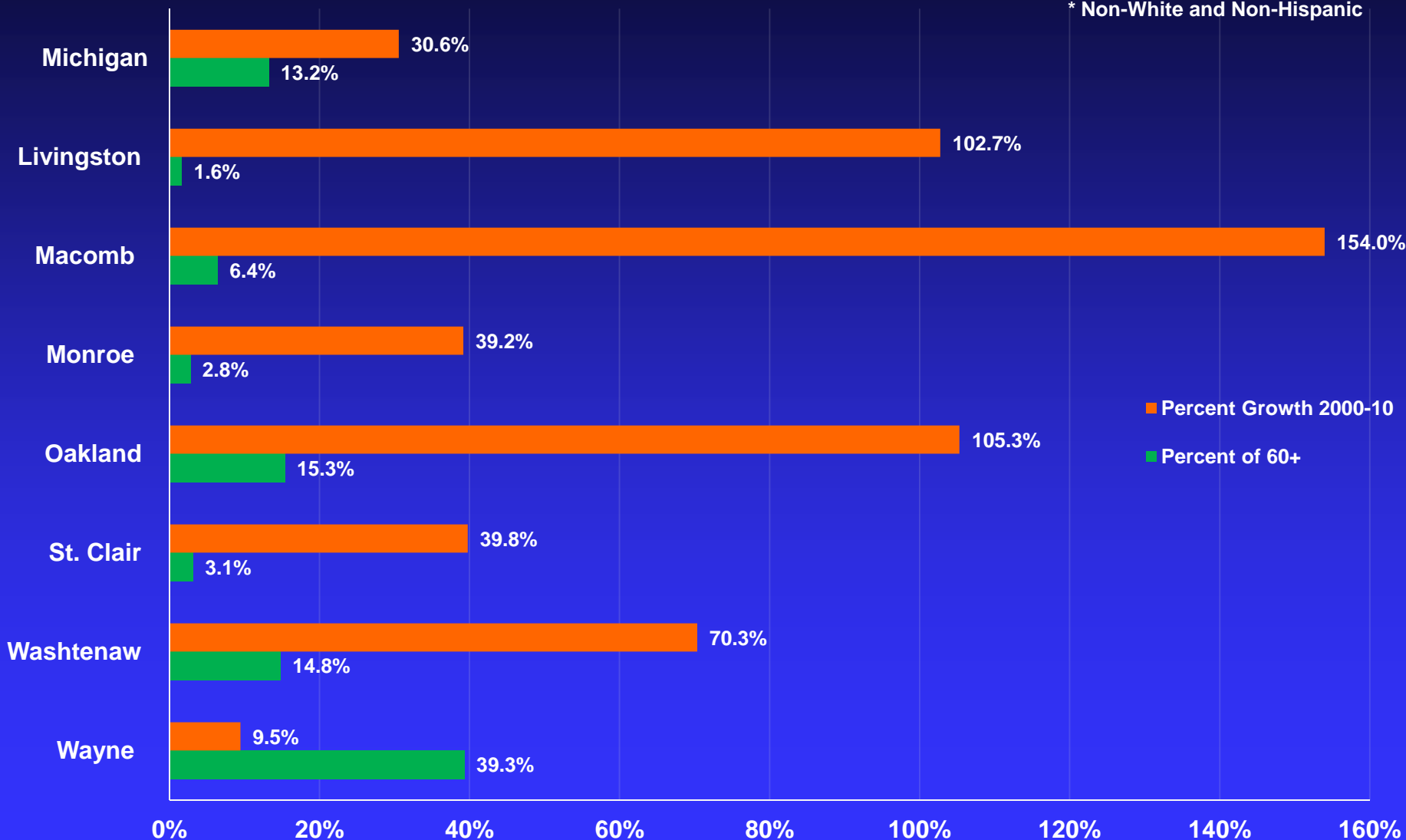
5-year age groups



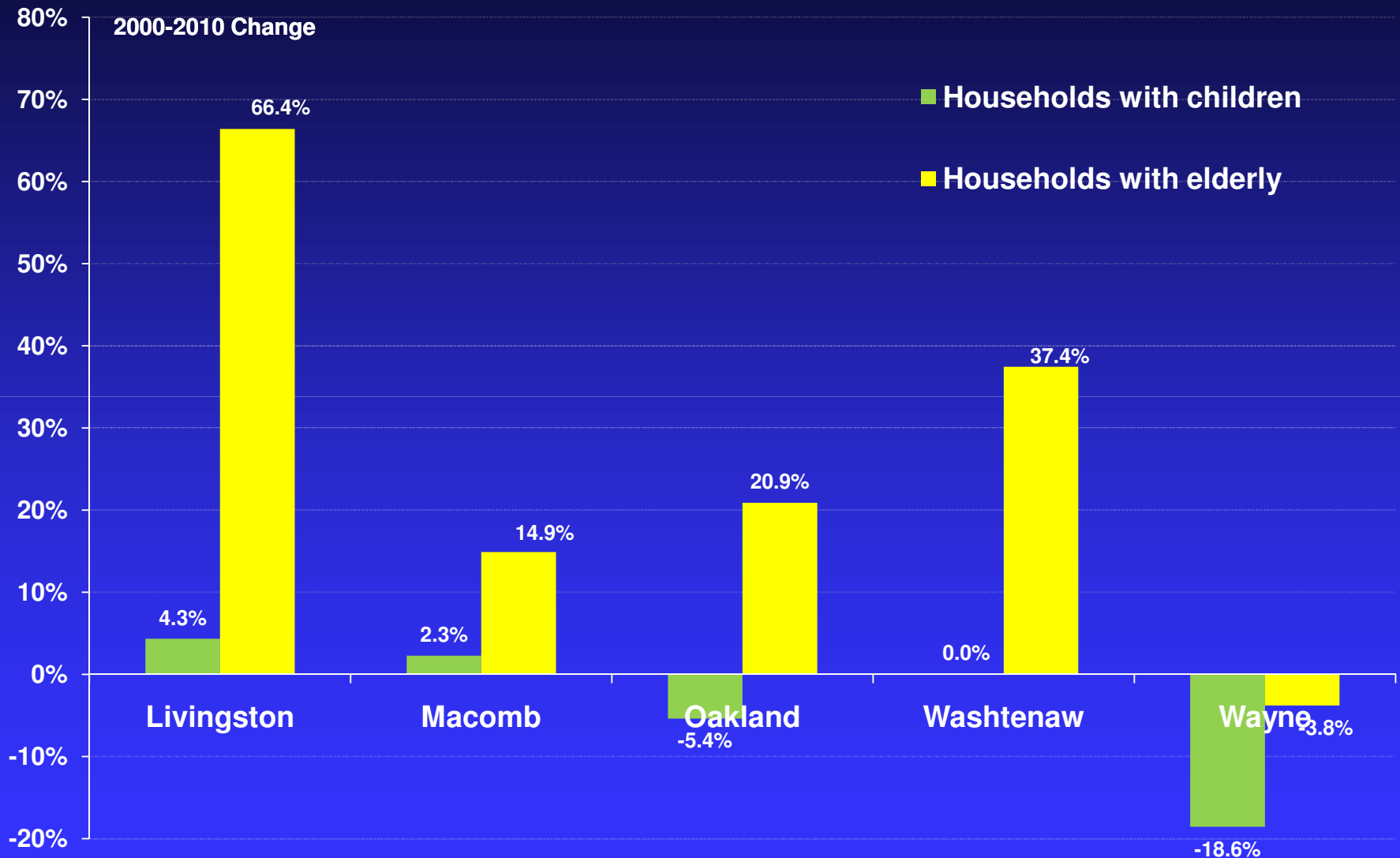

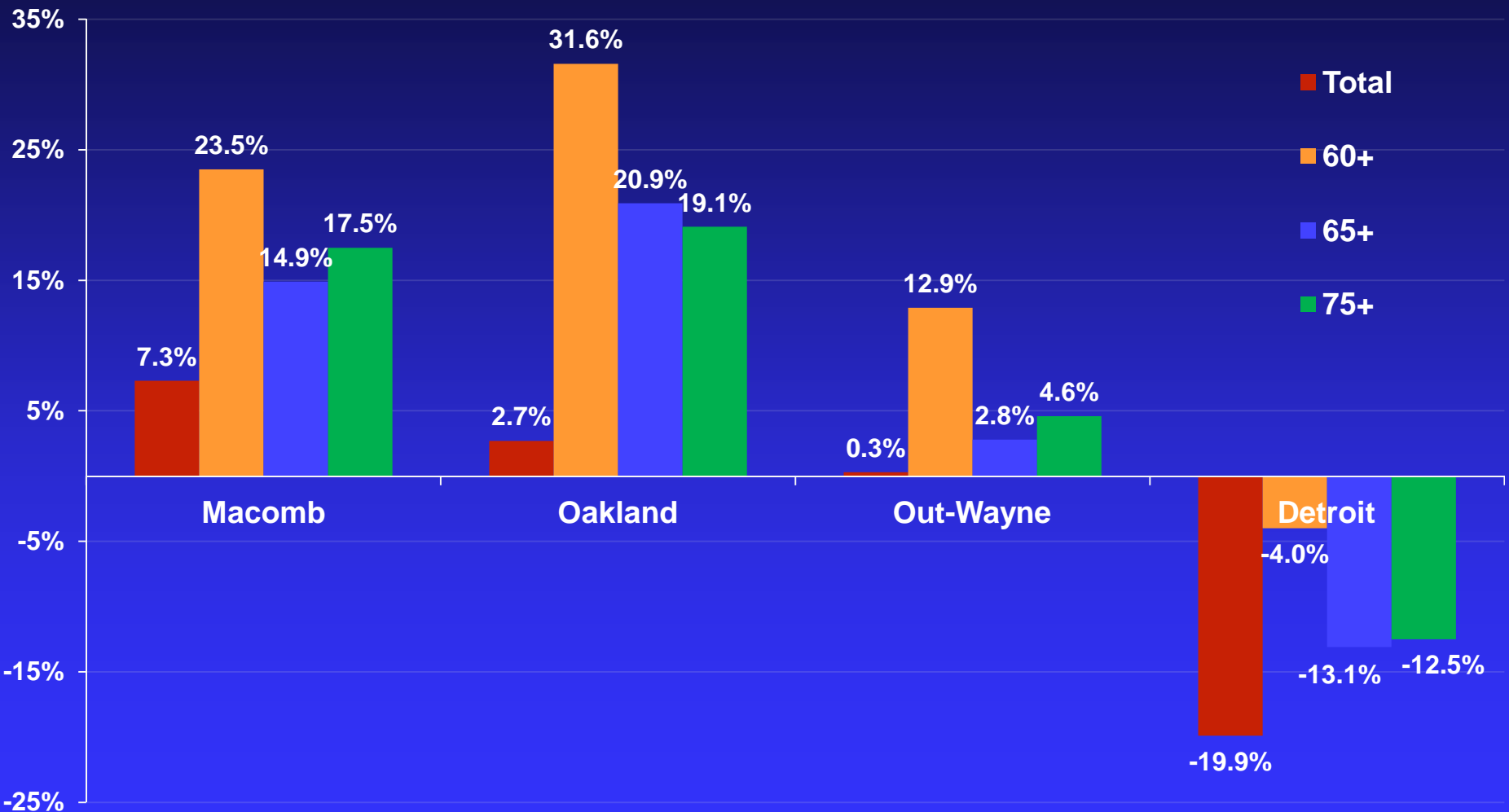


Households with Elderly Are Outpacing Those With Children

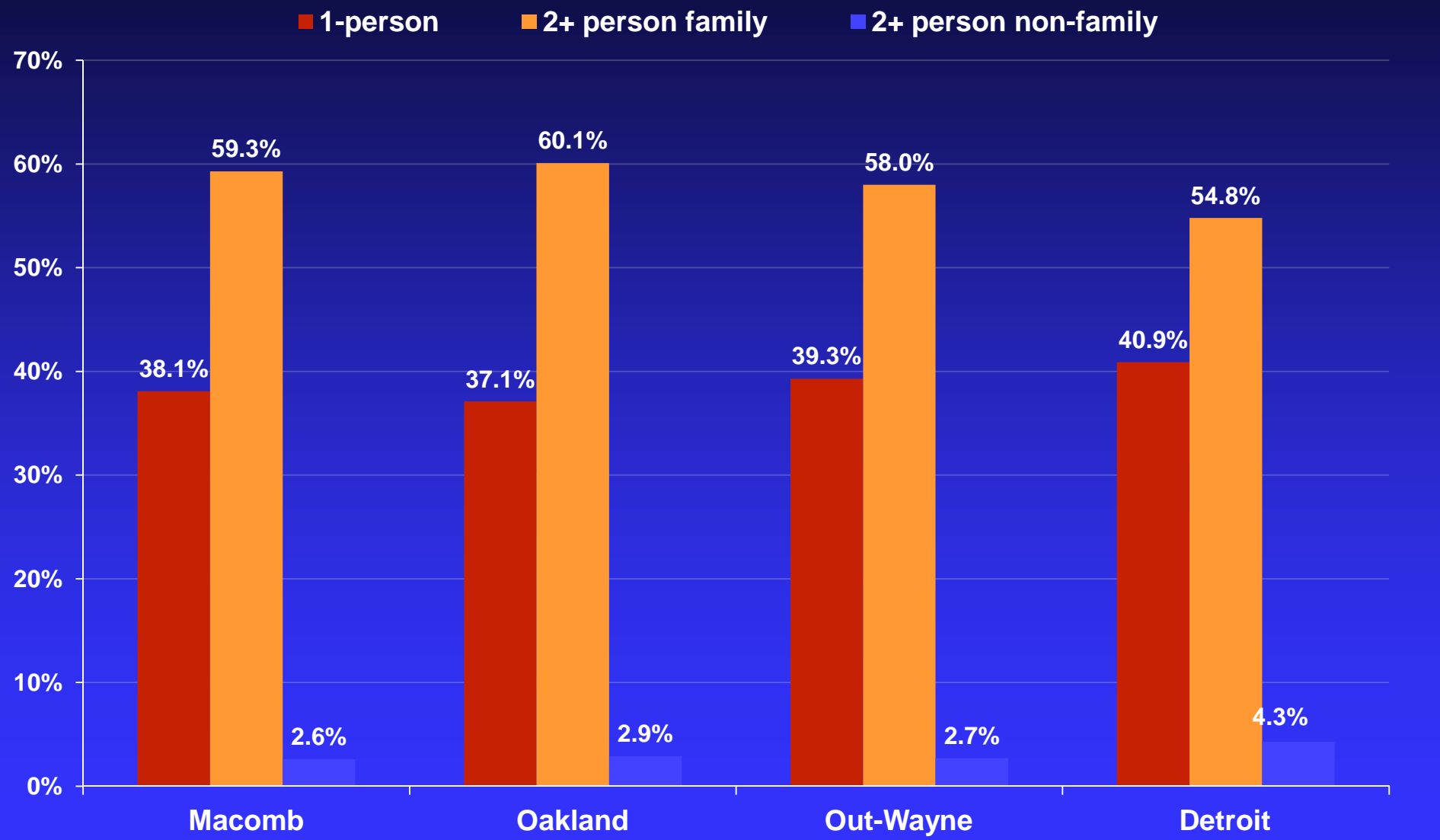

The Aging of Early Baby Boomers Drove the Growth of Households With At Least 1 Person 60 Years of Age

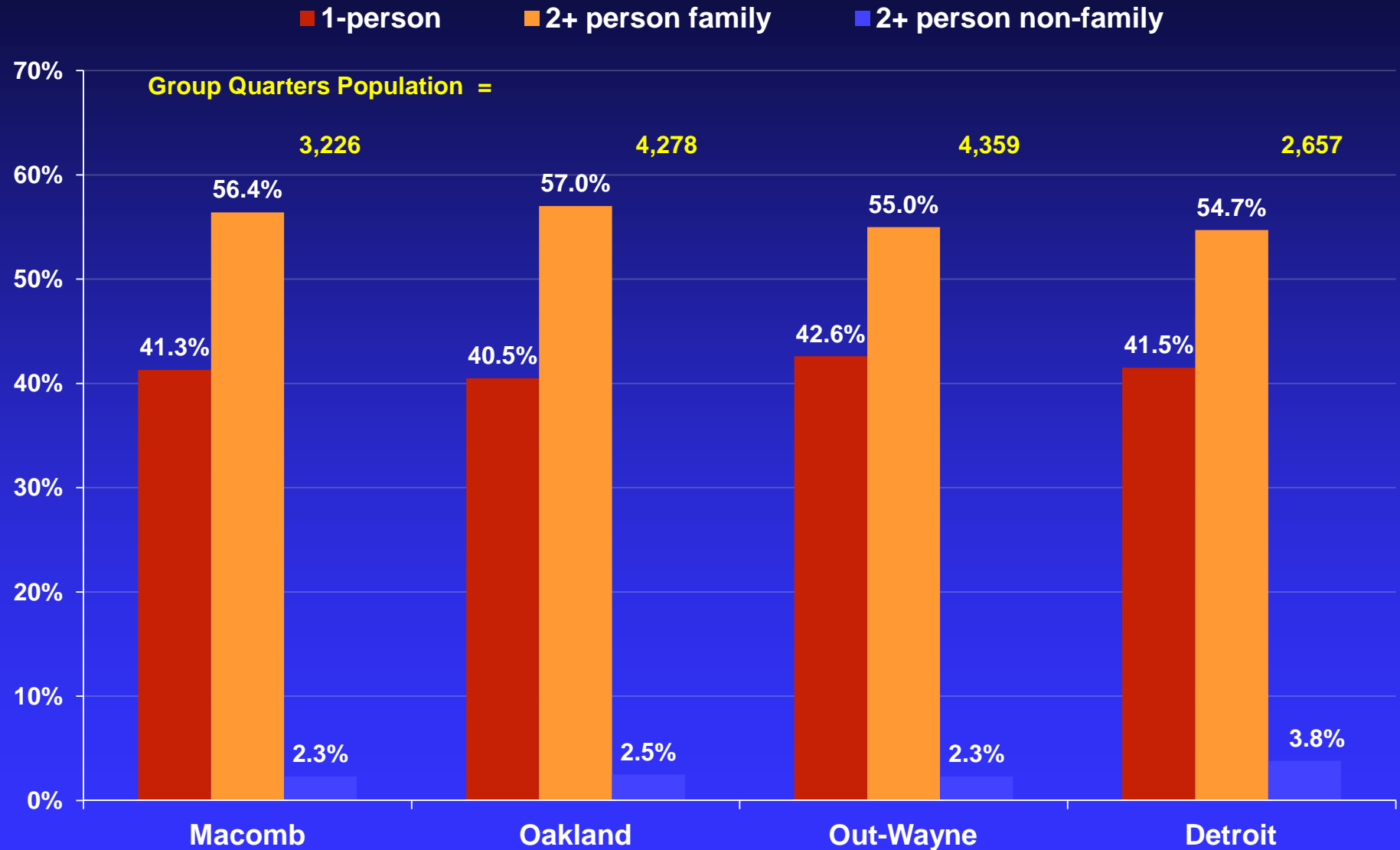


Three of Five Persons 60 Years of Age and Over Lived in a Family Household

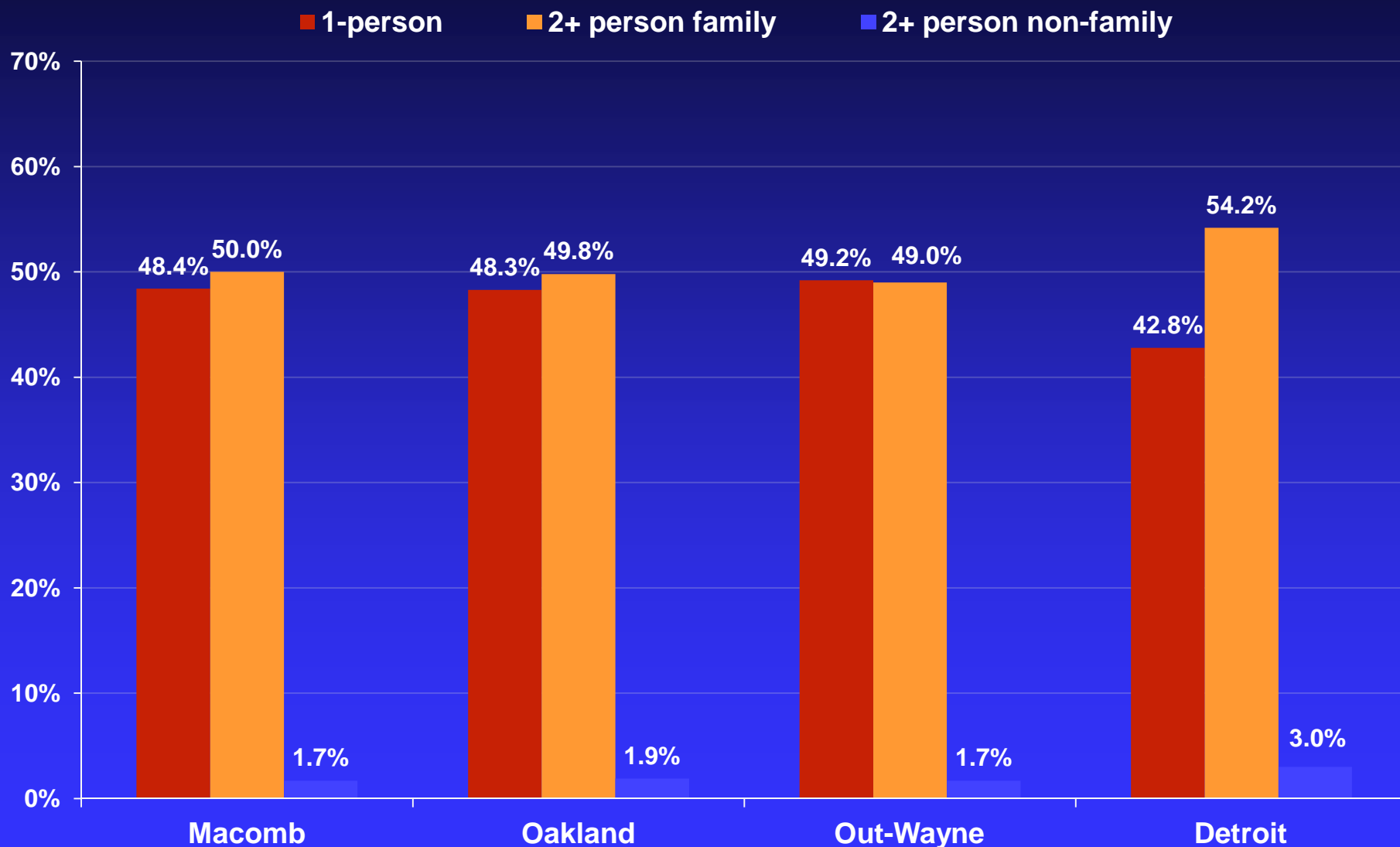

Persons 75 Years of Age and Over Were As Likely to Live Alone as Live in a Family Household

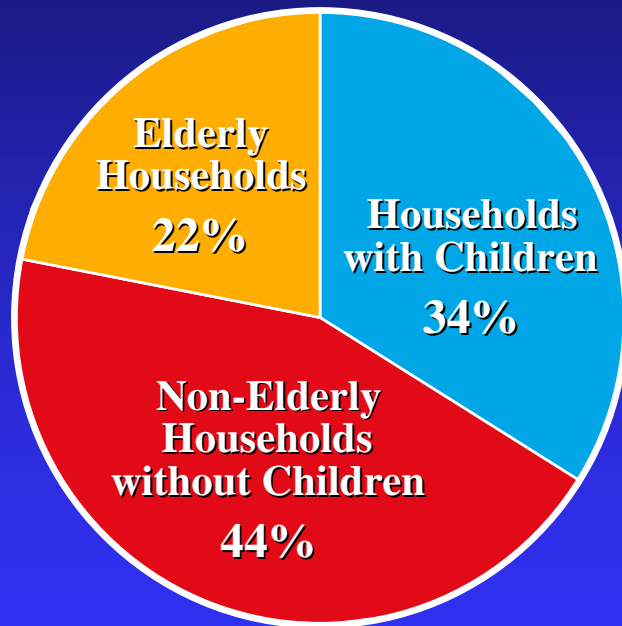

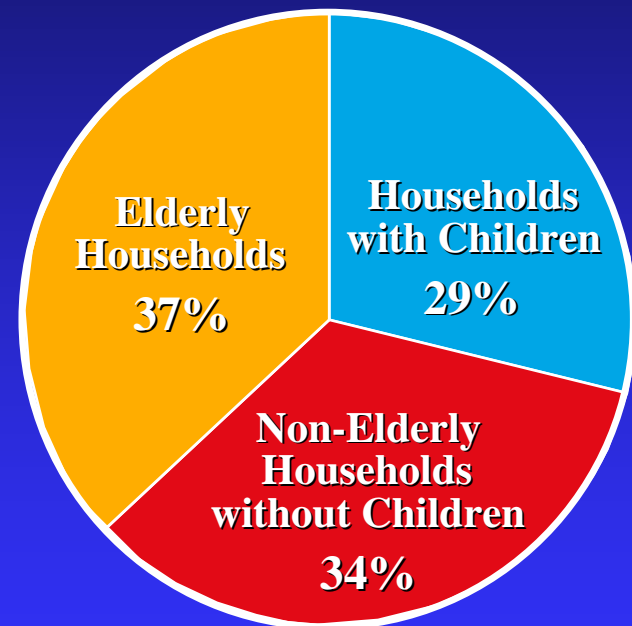

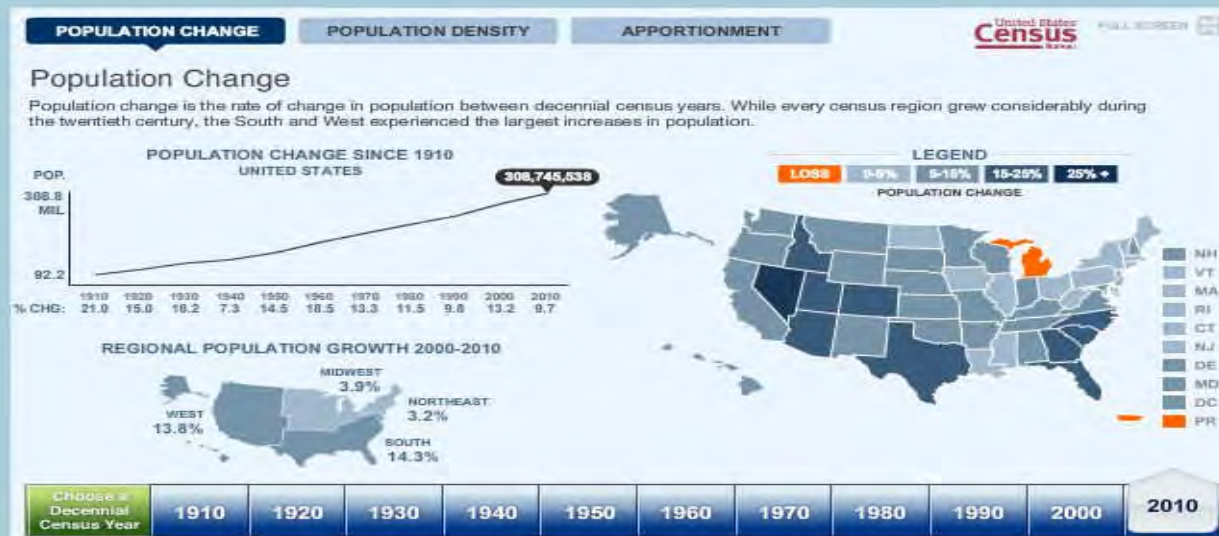
