

Publications

Publications from recent years are available for download. These publications are posted in the Adobe Portable Document Format (PDF). The Adobe Acrobat Reader software, a shareware program, is needed to view these files.

These pages provide two avenues for searching through the CRC archives:

- One page provides a list of publications by year dating all the way back to CRC's inception in 1916
- A second page provides a list of publications by subject. An index has been created to search through this list.

Order Publications

Although recent publications can be downloaded, publications from earlier years will have to ordered. This page is a form to order individual publications or to have your name placed on our mailing list for future publications. Publications that show some demand will be given priority in being posted for download, so that others will not have to order the publication.

Data File

This page will include useful data and information not available in CRC publications. It will contain items of interest regarding state and local government organization and finance and material relevant to current policy debates.

WebLinks

This page is provided so that the CRC Web site can be a resource in connecting to other organizations that provide information or do research on public policy issues. This page is broken down into five sections. Links are provided to:

- 1) Other non-profit governmental research organizations that are located in many states;
- Other organizations that do research on Michigan state and local government public policy issues;
- 3) National organizations that do research or provide information on public policy issues;
- 4) Michigan state government Web sites; and,
- 5) Federal government Web sites.
