**WAYNE COUNTY AND MACOMB COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICTS
BALLOT ISSUES**

Both Wayne County and Macomb Community Colleges are returning to the voters to seek approval of proposals defeated on August 4, 1992.

The Wayne County Community College request for approval of millage defeated in August 1992 would have authorized one mill for ten years; this request is for one mill for three years. Since August, WCCC has closed the Western campus.

Voters in Macomb County approved the Macomb Community College request for approval of a .33 mill operating levy to fund the University Center, but defeated the request for authorization to issue \$15.9 million of unlimited tax bonds. Macomb Community College has placed the same request for approval to sell bonds to update and replace equipment and renovate and preserve facilities and sites at three campuses on the November ballot.
